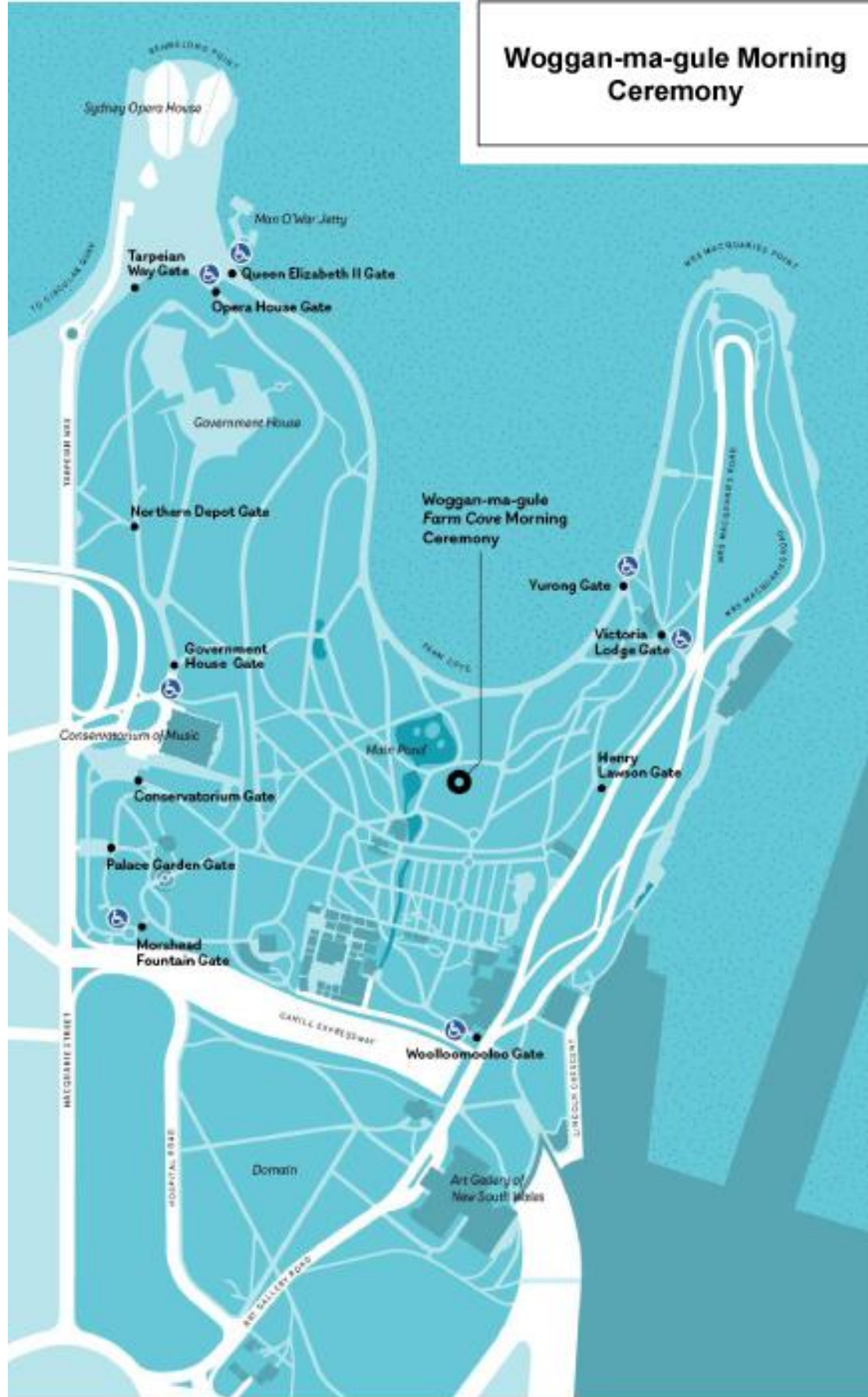

A special showcase in 2012 will be some of the veteran cars taking part in the 2012 Centenary Expedition. Many have names long forgotten – Minerva, Darracq, Maxwell, Sizaire Naudin – and in pride of place will be a 1910 Brush, the same model that featured in the original trip.

**WHEN:** 10:30am – 5.00pm

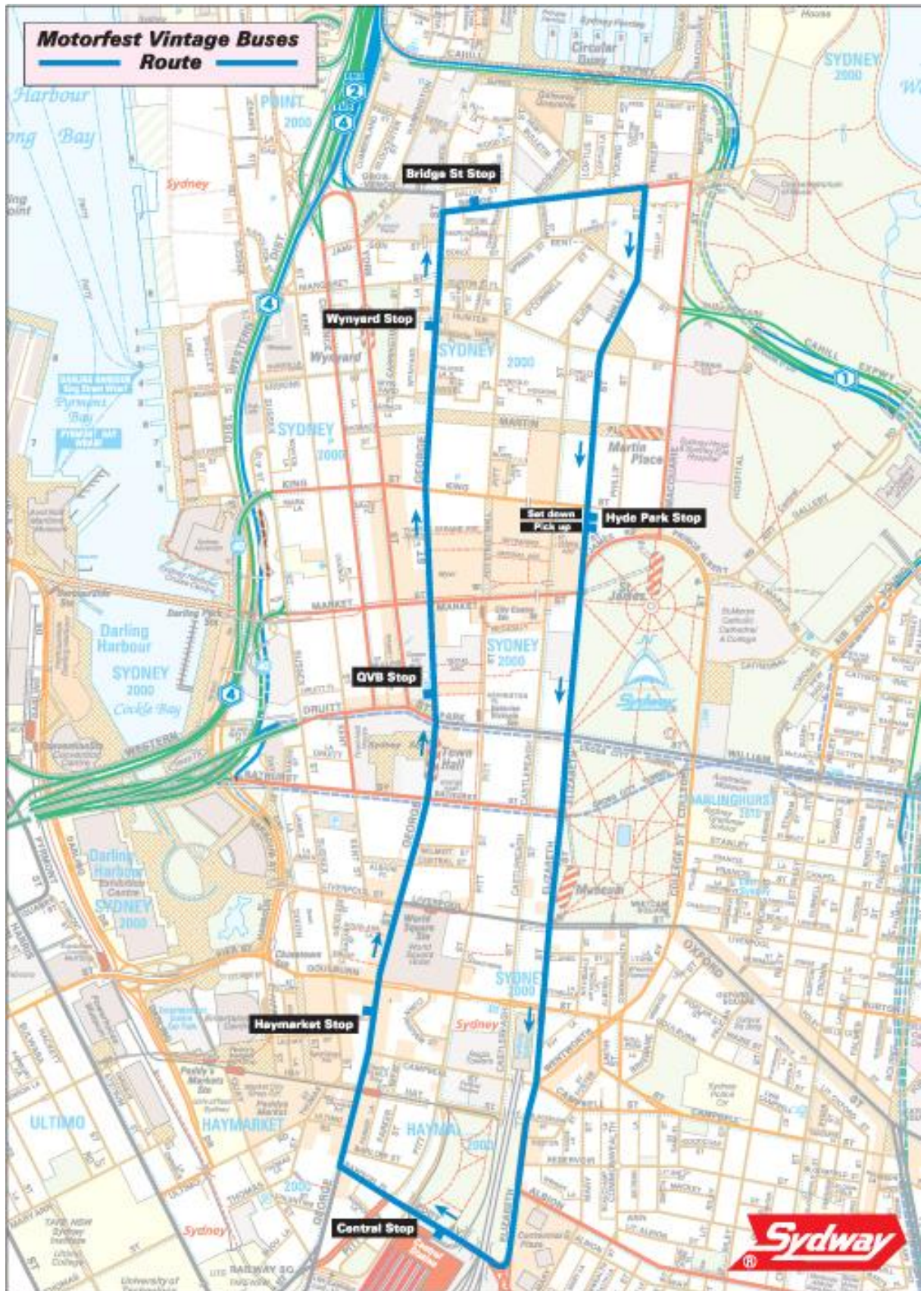
**WHERE:** Stops at specially marked spots along George, Bridge, Elizabeth, Hay Streets
