## AUSTRALIA DAY LIVE' ACCESSIBLE VIEWING AREA OVERSEAS PASSENGER TERMINAL WHARF

This information fact sheet is for guests who have registered for the designated accessible viewing area at the Overseas Passenger Terminal Wharf for Australia Day Live.

### Event Overview

Australia Day is a day to reflect, respect and celebrate the Australian spirit and the best of this country – our mateship, our sense of community and our resilience.

You and your guests will have access to view unforgettable musical performances on the big screen, spectacular fireworks and the maritime display on Sydney Cove. Australia Day Live runs from 7.30pm to 9.30pm.

### Getting There

Plan your trip and consider all the available travel options ahead of time. Public transport is the easiest way to get around on Australia Day with major transport hubs within short walking distance to your viewing area.

On arrival to the Overseas Passenger Terminal accessible viewing area, you will be greeted by our friendly staff who will, mark your name off and issue you with a wristband for your area.

### Public Transport

Circular Quay is the closest transport hub with a short 6-minute walk to your viewing area with frequent trains, buses, ferries and light rail services. Alternatively, Wynyard, Martin Place and St James transport hubs are also within walking distance. Some transport services will be affected by exclusion zones on the harbour and road closures. ### Designated drop-off/pick-up locations

Following are the pick-up and drop-off points closest to your viewing area. These areas are no parking zones or Special Event Clearways so persons utilising the areas will be required to move on as soon as they have dropped off their passengers.

The Rocks	Harrington St – western side (in front of Clock Tower Square)	All day
Pitt St	South of Reiby Place (Opposite Export Finance House)	Before 7:30pm and after 10:30pm
Loftus St	1 Loftus St – in front of Paragon Hotel and McDonald's	Before 7:30pm and after 10:30pm

## Event Facilities

- This is an outdoor event. You are encouraged to come prepared for the forecast weather as the accessible viewing area does not have shade or shelter
- Please be advised that seating will be provided at this location
- Drink plenty of water, wear sunscreen and appropriate clothing for summer weather conditions

### Accessible toilets

Accessible toilets will be available at all major hub areas on Australia Day and in close proximity to the Overseas Passenger Terminal. There are also existing accessible amenities at Circular Quay Station.

### Water Hydration Stations

To ensure you are kept hydrated, covid safe accessible water stations will be located throughout the event to provide guests with access to free refillable drinking water. So, don't forget to bring along you own bottle to refill.

## Terms and Conditions on Entry

### Security Check Points

Entry to Circular Quay and surrounding areas will be through a security check points. A priority entry lane for accessibility guests will be provided at each security check point. Patrons, their bags and other items may be searched or screened for safety and security purposes.

### Prohibited items

- Alcohol
- Flammable devices (flares, fireworks and smoke bombs)
- Glass
- Drones or unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs)
- Umbrella
- Illegal substances
- Laser pointers
- Sharp items including knives

With the evolving COVID-19 situation, the Australia Day Live may be subject to change. Our priority is to keep the community COVID Safe. So, we're staying on top of public health orders and following their advice — and we'll also work to keep you updated with event changes too.
